In her talk Laura will share some highlights from a new project on the history of local roads and transportation networks, and preparations for the commemoration of the Sesquicentennial of the Transcontinental Railroad in 2019.

As a dynamic program unfolds, we'll follow Dr. Laura Jones into her world as archaeologist as she links local people, places, and meanings across historical contexts.
